Getting Here

Centrally located, The Wharf is Washington, DC's waterfront destination that is easy to get to—and to get around. It is reachable through all imaginable modes of transportation, from car and public transportation to bike and boat.

- 1 Walk to two Metro stations (Waterfront for the Green line and L'Enfant Plaza for the Blue, Orange, Silver, Yellow, and Green lines, plus VRE) or take our free shuttle
- 2 Ride your bike or rent one from our Capital Bikeshare stations and enjoy easy access to DC's many bike lanes and the Riverwalk Trail System
- 3 Dock your boat at the Wharf Market Docks or Day Docks

- 4 Catch a water taxi to Georgetown, Old Town Alexandria, or National Harbor
- 5 Drive to The Wharf-we're just off 7th Street SW with direct access to the Southeast-Southwest Freeway and I-395
- 6 Fly into Reagan National Airport and get to The Wharf in only 10 minutes via car or Metro
- 7 Take Metro, bus, or car to Union Station for convenient Amtrak and MARC train connections
